ABOUT USDAN:

Usdan opens up a world for children to joyfully express their creativity and develop their artistic skills. Each summer, Usdan brings professional teachers and artists – actors, directors, playwrights, painters, sculptors, musicians, composers, dancers, poets, and novelists – to teach and collaborate with our campers, ages 5 to 18. Set on 140 acres of natural beauty in Wheatley Heights, Long Island, NY. Usdan is a safe, welcoming place within which campers have the freedom to build new friendships, explore nature, develop personal independence, and have fun, alongside their art making.

POSITION SUMMARY:

Over an 8- week camp season, Counselors are assigned to a group of campers for each 1-, 4-, or 8-week session. Counselors remain with their groups throughout the camp day to provide the campers with necessary supervision and care in addition to supporting Lead Teachers during classes. Counselors are responsible for the following:

- In some cases working with a co-counselor;
 - Working with assigned, consistent group of campers (18 campers per group maximum, depending on age) throughout the day;
 - Meeting campers at the beginning of the camp day and assisting with their dismissal at the end of the camp day;
 - Escorting an assigned group of campers to all scheduled activities and classes throughout the day;
 - Participating in classes with the campers and providing support to Lead Teachers;
 - Supervising campers during snack time, lunch time, and on the way to and from the bathrooms and the nurse;
 - Providing activities and engaging campers during the extended break between lunchtime and classes;
 - Ensuring student safety throughout the day;
 - Communicating with the Department Coordinator or Chair about student needs and behaviors; and
 - Attending training sessions.
- The Director of Education, Department Chair or Coordinator may assign additional supporting responsibilities.

Counselors work with a team of arts and education professionals to support a diverse body of students.



Successful candidates have a willingness to try new things, welcome feedback, and are able to follow directions. They are adaptable, both in and out of the classroom, and enthusiastic about working with children. They are self-starters as well as collaborators, with the ability to learn and adapt to routines. Perhaps most importantly, successful candidates consistently demonstrate empathy and respect for children and colleagues.

To perform this job successfully, you must be able to work in an outdoor camp environment and communicate with students and other staff effectively. Usdan provides staff with protocols and [instructional philosophy](#) at the beginning of the season that they are expected to read and follow. At the same time, Usdan staff understand that new challenges may arise during the camp season and often work together to problem solve and determine solutions as we go.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

QUALIFICATIONS:

- One year of college study in an art form, education, or the equivalent knowledge, skills, and abilities.
- Experience working with children preferred.
- Must complete New York State required trainings, including but not limited to a Sexual Harrassment Prevention training and a Child Abuse and Neglect/Maltreatment Identification. Links to required trainings will be provided after hiring.
- Must be [up to date vaccinations against COVID-19](#), before the first day of the camp season. Requests for accommodations are subject to approval by senior management.

2023 SUMMER SEASON DATES AND TIMES:

- Monday - Friday, June 26 - August 18, 2023, 9:15 AM - 3:15 PM, closed July 4.
- Pre-season commitments include:
 - o Staff Orientation: tentatively scheduled for Saturday, June 3 OR Saturday, June 10, 9:30am - 4:30pm
 - o Family Orientation: Tuesday, June 20, 2023 (a two and a half hour event to host families in the studios on campus).

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS:

- Counselors will be provided with a stipend for all of the work performed during and in preparation for the camp season. The stipend for an 8-week session starts at \$3,800.
- Family orientation, staff orientation, and any additional approved pre-season time is paid at an hourly rate.



- Complimentary use of studio space for their own artistic purposes, pre- and post-season, pending availability; semi-weekly use of swimming pool after camp hours; and occasional use of other facilities (*e.g.* tennis courts).
- Usdan summer camp tuition discounts for school aged dependents of faculty.
- Workshops in subjects like yoga, ceramics, and archery with other faculty and staff, if offered.
- Transportation:
 - Free parking on campus
 - Counselors from the city may be asked to monitor buses, which requires riding the bus to and from camp and supervising students. Faculty and staff who serve as bus monitors will receive a stipend of \$400-\$700, depending on assignment.
