ABOUT USDAN:

Usdan opens a world for children to joyfully express their creativity and develop their artistic skills. Each summer, Usdan brings professional teachers and artists – actors, directors, playwrights, painters, sculptors, musicians, composers, dancers, poets, and novelists – to teach and collaborate with our campers, ages 5 to 18. Set on 140 acres of natural beauty in Wheatley Heights, Long Island, NY. Usdan is a safe, welcoming place within which campers have the freedom to build new friendships, explore nature, develop personal independence, and have fun, alongside their art making.

POSITION SUMMARY:

- Maintenance staff perform the following duties to maintain a safe, clean, and organized campus for our students, faculty, and staff.
- Cleaning activities such as mopping, sweeping, dusting, disinfecting, cleaning windows, vacuuming, and garbage removal.
- Gardening/Upkeep of campgrounds: leaf blowing, raking, mulching, removal of tree branches, clearing walking trails, removal of trash and debris.
- Safely transporting musical instruments, packages, water coolers, and other items to and from various areas.
- Preparation of campus for camp season: painting pools, deep cleaning of studios, and setting up picnic tables.
- Assisting with parking during staff arrival and events.
- Daily maintenance of assigned area on campus before and after camp hours.
- Preparation of campus for camp season: painting pools, deep cleaning of studios, and setting up picnic tables.
- Other duties as assigned.

The above job description is not intended to be an all-inclusive list of duties and standards of the position. Maintenance staff will be expected to follow any other instructions, and perform any other related duties, as assigned by their supervisor.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 16 years old.
- Must complete New York State required trainings, including but not limited to a Sexual Harassment Prevention training and a Child Abuse and Neglect/Maltreatment Identification. Links to required trainings will be provided after hiring.



- Must be [up to date vaccinations against COVID-19](#), before the first day of the camp season. Requests for accommodations are subject to approval by senior management.
- CPR training is not required but a plus
- Have reliable transportation to Usdan's campus. Requests for accommodations are subject to approval by senior management.

2023 SUMMER SEASON DATES AND TIMES:

- Monday - Friday, June 26 - August 18, 2023, varying shifts 7 AM - 5 PM, closed July 4.
- Pre-season commitments include:
 - Preseason campus prep in May
 - Staff Orientation: Saturday, June 3

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS:

- \$15 per hour, at least 25 hours per week in season
- Complimentary use of studio space for their own artistic purposes, pre- and post-season, pending availability; semi-weekly use of swimming pool after camp hours; and occasional use of other facilities (e.g. tennis courts).
- Workshops in subjects like yoga, ceramics, and archery with other faculty and staff, if offered.
- Transportation:
 - Additional opportunities to serve as a bus monitor, which consists of riding the bus to and from camp and supervising students. Faculty and staff will receive a stipend (\$400-\$700)

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Usdan is a 140-acre campus with facilities spread throughout - distances vary and are along uneven surfaces, up and down hills. Some facilities are elevated and require one to two stairs to enter. Although this position mostly consists of office work, there will be many opportunities for this position to traverse the campus, especially during the summer season. Some staff walk an average of two miles per day. Other physical demands include the ability to work in a hot, humid environment; the ability to speak clearly and understand the speech of another person; and the ability to prioritize sounds and focus on one sound among many.

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential physical functions of this position.
