ABOUT USDAN:

Usdan opens up a world for children to joyfully express their creativity and develop their artistic skills. Each summer, Usdan brings professional teachers and artists – actors, directors, playwrights, painters, sculptors, musicians, composers, dancers, poets, and novelists – to teach and collaborate with our campers, ages 5 to 18. Set on 140 acres of natural beauty in Wheatley Heights, Long Island, NY. Usdan is a safe, welcoming place within which campers have the freedom to build new friendships, explore nature, develop personal independence, and have fun, alongside their art making.

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Safety Monitors will be responsible for monitoring and escorting students on campus at Usdan Summer Camp for the Arts. Additional supporting responsibilities may be assigned. All work will take place at Usdan's campus in Huntington, Long Island, NY.

To perform this job successfully, you must be able to work in an outdoor camp environment and communicate with students and other staff effectively. Usdan provides staff with protocols at the beginning of the season that they are expected to read and follow. At the same time, Usdan staff understand that new challenges may arise during the camp season and often work together to problem solve and determine solutions as we go.

Safety Monitors will be friendly, outgoing, lovers of the arts, who are focused on growing and learning. They will work enthusiastically with children, be flexible and be able to follow directions. They will be authentic, reliable, respectful, thoughtful, and organized. Safety Monitors will be self-starters as well as collaborators. Safety Monitors must have excellent communication skills and be able to communicate well with students, staff, peers, nurses and parents and react quickly in safety sensitive situations, while respecting confidentiality and privacy.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Be 17 years of age as of June 27, 2022.
- Certification in Child Abuse and Neglect/Maltreatment Identification (can be obtained online at no cost).
- Experience working with Children.



- Must complete New York State required trainings, including but not limited to a Sexual Harassment Prevention training and a Child Abuse and Neglect/Maltreatment Identification. Links to required trainings will be provided after hiring.
- Must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, and if eligible as defined by the CDC, have received a COVID-19 booster shot, before the first day of the camp season.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

- Studios are spread out throughout the 140 acre campus. Distances vary and are along uneven surfaces, up and down hills. Some studios are elevated and require one to two stairs to enter. Some staff walk an average of two miles per day. Other physical demands include the ability to work in a hot, humid environment; the ability to speak clearly and understand the speech of another person; and the ability to prioritize sounds and focus on one sound among many.
- The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential physical functions of this position.

2022 SUMMER SEASON DATES AND TIMES:

- Monday - Friday, June 27 - August 19, 2022, 9:00 AM - 3:15 PM, closed July 4.
- Pre-season commitments include:
 - o Staff Orientation: tentatively scheduled for Saturday, June 4 AND Saturday, June 11, 9:30am-2:30pm (a two-day event pre-season, usually on a weekend).
 - o Family Orientation: TBD (a three-hour event to host families in the studios on campus. Usually on a weeknight in June).

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS:

- Summer Stipend - \$3,510. Orientations will be an additional stipend
- Usdan summer camp tuition discounts for school aged dependents of staff.
- Workshops in subjects like yoga, ceramics, and archery with other faculty and staff, if offered.
- Transportation:
 - NYC staff can earn extra income by being a bus monitor from city locations.
 - NYC faculty and staff will also be able to apply for a transportation subsidy.
 - Free parking on campus
