ABOUT USDAN:

Usdan opens a world for children to joyfully express their creativity and develop their artistic skills. Each summer, Usdan brings professional teachers and artists – actors, directors, playwrights, painters, sculptors, musicians, composers, dancers, poets, and novelists – to teach and collaborate with our campers, ages 5 to 18. Set on 140 acres of natural beauty in Wheatley Heights, Long Island, NY. Usdan is a safe, welcoming place within which campers have the freedom to build new friendships, explore nature, develop personal independence, and have fun, alongside their art making.

POSITION SUMMARY:

Over an 8-week camp season, Swim Attendants help monitor and supervise students as they enter, participate in, and exit Swim. Swim Attendants are responsible for:

- Checking students into Swim class
- Assisting with buddy checks on deck during Swim class.
- Monitoring changing rooms.
- Complying with Usdan policies and procedures, including daily arrival and departure time

Swim Attendants work with a team of swim and recreation staff to support a diverse body of students.

Successful candidates are flexible and willing to work in all weather conditions. They are enthusiastic about working with children and are able to follow supervisors' directions. They are reliable, punctual, respectful, and organized. They can work independently and on a team. They have a "can-do" attitude with the ability to find "yes." Perhaps most importantly, they have respect and empathy for both students and other staff.

To perform this job successfully, you must be able to work in an outdoor camp environment and communicate with students and other staff effectively. Usdan provides staff with protocols at the beginning of the season that they are expected to read and follow. Usdan staff understand that new challenges may arise during the camp season and often work together to problem solve and determine solutions as we go.



The above job description is not intended to be an all-inclusive list of duties and standards of the position. Swim Attendants will be expected to follow any other instructions, and perform any other related duties, as assigned by their supervisor.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Must complete New York State required trainings, including but not limited to a Sexual Harassment Prevention training and a Child Abuse and Neglect/Maltreatment Identification. Links to required trainings will be provided after hiring.
- Must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, and if eligible as defined by the CDC, have received a COVID-19 booster shot, before the first day of the camp season.
- CPR is not required but a plus
- Have reliable transportation to Usdan's campus.

2022 SUMMER SEASON DATES AND TIMES:

- Monday - Friday, June 27 - August 19, 2022, 9:15 AM - 3:15 PM, closed July 4.
- Required pre-season commitments include:
 - o Staff Orientation: tentatively scheduled for Saturday, June 4 AND Saturday, June 11, 9:30am-2:30pm (a two-day event pre-season, usually on a weekend).
- A few swim staff members will have opportunities to work additional hours, compensated at an hourly rate, as a pool cleaner.

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS:

- Swim Attendants will be provided with a stipend to cover all work performed during and in preparation for the camp season. Stipend for an 8-week session starts at \$3,260, depending on candidate's experience. Staff orientation is paid at an additional day rate.
- Complimentary use of studio space for their own artistic purposes, pre- and post-season, pending availability; semi-weekly use of swimming pool after camp hours; and occasional use of other facilities (e.g. tennis courts).
- Workshops in subjects like yoga, ceramics, and archery with other faculty and staff, if offered.
- Transportation:
 - Free parking on campus
 - Additional opportunities to serve as a bus monitor, which consists of riding the bus to and from camp and supervising students. Faculty and staff will receive a stipend (\$400-\$700)
