POSITION SUMMARY

Help us shape and share the story of Usdan Summer 2021.

The camp videographer will be responsible for capturing and creating high quality and engaging content to share with Usdan's community including parents and caregivers, donors, and partners. The videographer will also record and create content for special events including professional performances, the annual Gala fundraiser, and the work of our Artists in Residence. Additionally, they may work on collecting content on specific themes for off-season marketing videos as directed by the Manager of Marketing & Communications and the Executive Director. Themes may include Usdan's main values of sustainability, equity, health & safety, community, and youth creativity.

This is a flexible position in terms of schedule and pay that depends on the videographer's, interests, experience, and schedule.

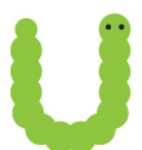
RESPONSIBILITIES & DELIVERABLES

- Film daily camp activities, professional performances, and special events. *
- Edit regular roundup videos to share with Usdan's community.
- Edit clips for social media posting.
- Work on projects around certain themes for off-season marketing videos.
- Oversee the recording and/or live streaming of a curated number of performances on campus.

*Professional performances may not run in 2021 due to COVID guideline restrictions.

TRAITS & CHARACTERISTICS

- Film editing experience required.
- Open to collaborating on projects with Usdan staff.
- Positive attitude.

- Ability to take direction and work autonomously.
- Experience with live streaming desired including the ability to oversee a two-camera live performance with independent soundboard feed.
- Comfortable being outside in a high-energy, fast-paced work environment
- Strength in engaging with people; should be able to interact and engage with students (K–12th grade), families, teachers and professional performers.

- Staff Orientation: Saturday, June 5, time TBD, at camp.
- Family Orientation: Date TBD.
- Summer Season: Monday – Friday, June 28 – August 20, 2021; closed July 3.
- This is a flexible position in terms of schedule and pay that depends on the videographer’s interests, experience, and schedule.
 - Videographer should be on campus at least 2 days per week. There will be some weeks that require additional days including:
 - July 19 – 23
 - August 9 – 13
 - August 16 – 20
 - Gala: Date TBD
 - Suggested hours: 9:30 AM – 4:30 PM (Open to discussion).

SALARY & BENEFITS

- Salary commensurate with experience and will be agreed upon once a schedule has been worked out based off an hourly wage of \$22 – \$30.
- We encourage our staff to utilize Usdan for their own artistic purposes. Proposals for pre-season studio use are welcome.
